Wellness Policy:

The flu season is upon us and we need your help to keep everyone well. We miss your children when they are not here, but we hope we can reduce how often they are not here by requiring the following policy:

We will ask you to keep children with you if they show signs of not being well and could be contagious to others. These signs are as stated, but not limited to the list below:

**Green or yellow nose mucous
Fever
Running eyes
Severe cough**

If your child has been on an antibiotic long enough that the doctor deems them not contagious we will make exceptions, but feel free to keep your children home until they are well. Give me a call as I would love to send them a "get well" card to let them know they are missed and prayed for.
